## Question 1:

1. Log into Scratch at ([scratch.mit.edu](http://scratch.mit.edu))
2. Go into your game
3. Make sure you have 3 sprites
  - a. Sprite 1: the first player controlled with arrows (right arrow, left arrow, up arrow, down arrow).
  - b. Sprite 2: the second player controlled with (W, A, S, D)
  - c. Sprite 3: this is the smaller sprite that will be eaten for the two players.
4. Add 2 variables:
  - a. One variable for score1 (increment when sprite 1 eats sprite 3)
  - b. One variable for score2 (increments when sprite 2 eats sprite 3)
5. Create 2 new backdrops
  - a. One backdrop for when player 1 wins (comes on when score 1 is 3)
  - b. One backdrop for when player 2 wins (comes on when score 2 is 3)
6. Have fun!

1. Add a third player into the game that can be played with the letters (Y, G, H, J)

### Scenario one: A Complaint
